SUBJECT: Command Policy Memorandum # 15 - Retention Incentive Award Program

1. REFERENCE: AR 601-280, Total Army Retention Program.
2. PURPOSE: To recognize the efforts and dedication of Unit Reenlistment NCOs, in the accomplishment of the Battalions retention mission. To recognize high quality soldiers for reenlisting, enlisting or transferring into the reserves and or extending for BEAR or special programs.
3. OBJECTIVES: To establish a competitive atmosphere among commanders, ensure command influence at all levels, and to ensure success in the accomplishment of the mission assignments in a timely manner.
4. AWARDS:
 - a. Soldiers reenlisting of enlisting transfers into reserve or extending for BEAR will receive a four-day pass and the day of reenlistment off. The pass will be taken at a time mutually agreed upon by the soldier and the chain of command within 30 days of reenlistment.
 - b. Quarterly: For meeting the Brigade Retention Objectives, the Battalion Reenlistment NCO will receive a Battalion Certificate of Achievement and a three-day pass. The pass will be taken at a time mutually agreed upon by the NCO and the chain of command.
 - c. Yearly: For meeting all Quarterly Objectives, the Battalion Reenlistment NCO will receive a Department of the Army Certificate of Achievement, and a four-day pass.
